The results of this survey can help create the needed public pressure on your local and state representatives and your Governor to save your law enforcement from constant budget cuts that are thwarting them from doing their jobs to protect us, our families, our communities and even themselves.

Question 1: Alarming, state and local budget cuts are forcing thousands of our police officers to deal with anti-cop riots in the streets, criminals, -- and even active "ambush" cop killer threats -- without the proper training and equipment they need to do their jobs protecting us, our families and communities. **Before you received this letter were you aware of this problem?**

Question 2: With the radical anti-cop movement and the "Defund the Police" movement sweeping the country, horrible ambush cop-killings occurring at staggering rates -- and the constant threat of active shooters -- this is no time for many of our officers to lack lifesaving equipment like bulletproof vests, protective riot gear, emergency first aid trauma kits and other equipment needed to do their jobs. **Do you think your state and local legislators should make adequate funding of our police a top priority when deciding their budgets?**

Question 3: When our police are vulnerable for lack of lifesaving equipment, then those of us they protect are vulnerable as well. **Do you agree with that statement?**

Question 4: With so much of law enforcement training being watered-down largely due to the "politically-correct" movement, coupled with local budget cuts, many in law enforcement are not getting the cutting edge active shooter response training they need in today's world to protect themselves, us and our communities. **Before you received this letter were you aware of this severe police training problem?**

28% Yes **61% No** **11% Undecided**

Question 5: The federal Administration is a champion of law enforcement. But they don't have the power to control state and local budgets.
