I want to thank the United States Deputy Sheriff's Association for assisting the Peabody Police Department in acquiring much needed equipment. The Peabody Police Department is a very small rural police department in central Kansas, serving a community of 1200 residents. Recently the USDSA donated 4 sets of stop sticks and 6 belt carried trauma packs to the Peabody Police Department. The Peabody Police Department has never been able to afford the Stop Sticks, which are used by law enforcement in stopping a vehicle that poses a threat to the general public on our State's highways, roads, and streets.

The Peabody Police Department currently has 3 full time officers, and three part time officers working within 4 patrol units. The USDSA also donated 6 belt carried trauma packs for officers to have with them at all times in the case that a medical emergency arises.

I want to personally thank the United States Deputy Sheriff's Association for donating this equipment that otherwise would have been very difficult to obtain.
