Dear Mr. Willis,

I would like to thank you and the United States Deputy Sheriff's Association for awarding the Washita County Sheriff's Office with such a generous grant. Enough trauma belt kits were received to equip all of our Deputies including Reserve Deputies. Our deputies are oftentimes the first on scene at crashes or other trauma related calls and due to the rural nature of our jurisdiction, the response time of emergency medical services can be lengthy. These kits may very well save the life of a Citizen of Washita County or even a Washita County Deputy. Two preliminary breath tests were also received as part of the grant. In 2019, Washita County Deputies made 19 impaired driving reports. These PBT's will be used to combat impaired driving in Washita County and help keep our roads safe for the Citizens of Washita County. The Washita County Sheriff's Office additionally was awarded with two ballistic helmets. Washita County Deputies respond to violent calls with armed individuals at times and until now the Sheriff's Office has been unable to provide any of the deputies with ballistic helmets. Our Deputies are husbands, fathers, and sons who have every right to make it home after their shifts and these helmets will offer protection to help make sure that they do make it back home to their loved ones.
