

As Greer County Sheriff, I have been looking for ways to acquire new equipment to assist my deputies in their duties and responding to different types of calls across Greer County. One of our biggest obstacles is a limited budget. So, finding equipment that our deputies need in the field is important, but so is the cost.

We contacted the United States Deputy Sheriff's Association after learning that the organization donates equipment to agencies. There are a few items that we had on our wish list for our deputies. There are some tools and resources that would be very beneficial to my guys. One of which is a thermal vision system. We conveyed that to the USDSA and they came through with a FLIR Scout TK outdoor thermal vision system to the Greer County Sheriff's Office at no cost to the citizens of Greer County.

Whether searching for suspects in the dark, such as when the Oklahoma State Reformatory calls about a person in the area making a drop of contraband items on the prison grounds or searching for hikers near Quartz Mountain State Park or up at Sandy Sanders, these thermal vision systems provide much needed eyes in the dark and assistance in locating individuals. The FLIR system is an invaluable tool when a department like ours can get it. I would like to express my gratitude to the USDSA for their contribution to our office as we continue to strive towards being a department that the citizens of Greer County deserve and can be proud of.
